We are pleased to announce the Laneco FCU members voted by a 97% majority (246 yes votes and 7 no votes), to approve the merger of Laneco into Central Willamette Credit Union, effective July 1, 2024. We thank the many of you who supported this merger and to help us keep our history of providing affordable financial services to the greater Eugene and Lane County moving forward into the future.

Please note that in the meantime, the Eugene branch will be able to serve only Laneco FCU members until the CWCU systems, products, and services have been integrated later this year. We will keep you posted along the way as we move along the path of full integration with CWCU after July 1, 2024.
